International Keynote Speakers

DR KATHLEEN SLUKA

Dr Kathleen Sluka (PT, PhD, FAPTA) is Professor of Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation Science and Professor of Neuroscience and Pharmacology at the University of Iowa. Dr Sluka's laboratory studies the peripheral and central mechanisms of chronic musculoskeletal pain, and non-pharmacological treatment for chronic pain. Her overall goals are to improve the management of pain for people with a variety of musculoskeletal pain conditions by discovering the underlying mechanisms that lead to the development of chronic pain, discovering new therapies for pain management, and improving the use of currently available treatment for pain.



DR NATHAN D. ZASLER

Dr Nathan D. Zasler (MD, DABPM&R, FAAPM&R, FACRM, BIM, CBIST) is Founder, CEO & Medical Director of Concussion Care Centre of Virginia, as well as Founder and current Medical Director of Tree of Life in Richmond, Virginia. He is an affiliate professor in the VCU Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Richmond, VA, and a visiting professor in the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at the University of Virginia, Charlottesville. Dr Zasler is Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson Emeritus of the International Brain Injury Association (IBIA). Dr Zasler has published and lectured extensively on traumatic brain injury related neuromedical issues and is an advocate, educator, clinical researcher, inventor and entrepreneur.
